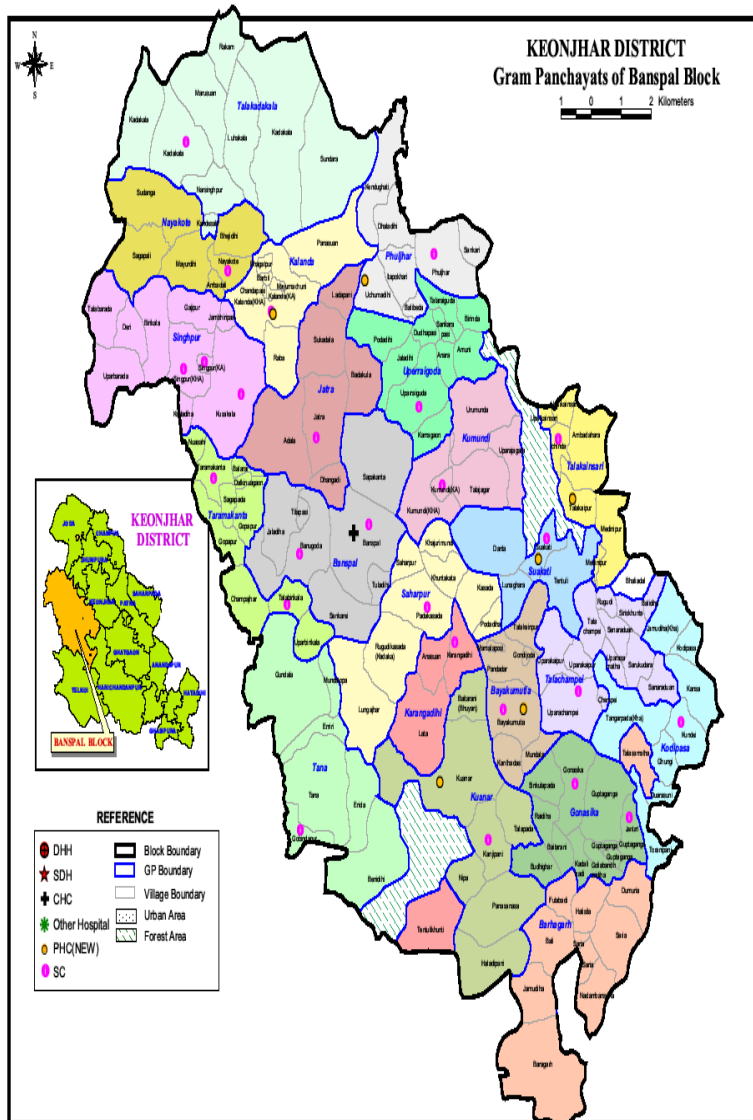

## Brief about Keonjhar & Banspal

The Keonjhar District emerged as one of the District on 1st January, 1948. The District is bounded by Mayurbhanj District and Bhadrak District to the east, Jajpur District to the south, Dhenkanal District and Sundargarh District to the west and West Singhbhum district of Jharkhand State to the north. Covering a geographical area of 8240 sq kms, the Keonjhar District lies between 21<sup>0</sup> 1' N to 22<sup>0</sup> 10' N latitude and 85<sup>0</sup> 11' E to 86<sup>0</sup> 22' E longitude.

Banspal Block was established on 01<sup>st</sup> April, 1960. The Block comes under Keonhar Sadar Sub division with area coverage of 1103.78 Sq. K.M.
